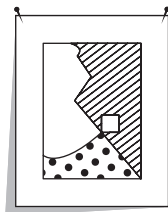
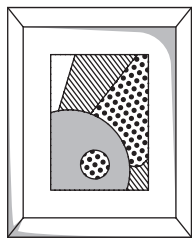
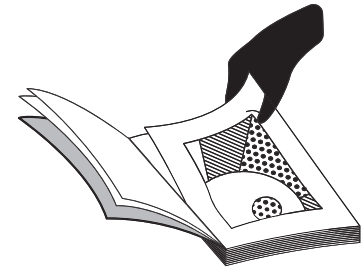


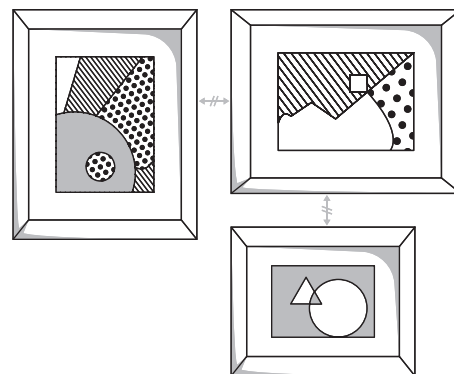
Creating Your Home Gallery



Prints can be framed or pinned to the wall with decorative thumb tacks.

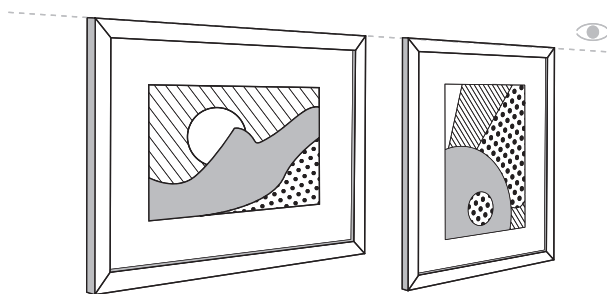
For an attractive display, the works should ideally be placed $1\frac{1}{4}$ to 2 in. (3 to 5 cm) apart. Ensure the frames are equally spaced.

Alternate between portrait (vertical) and landscape (horizontal) formats for variety and harmony.



Align certain frames so as to create visual lines and add structure to the overall display.

Try distancing similar designs from each other to create additional visual interest.

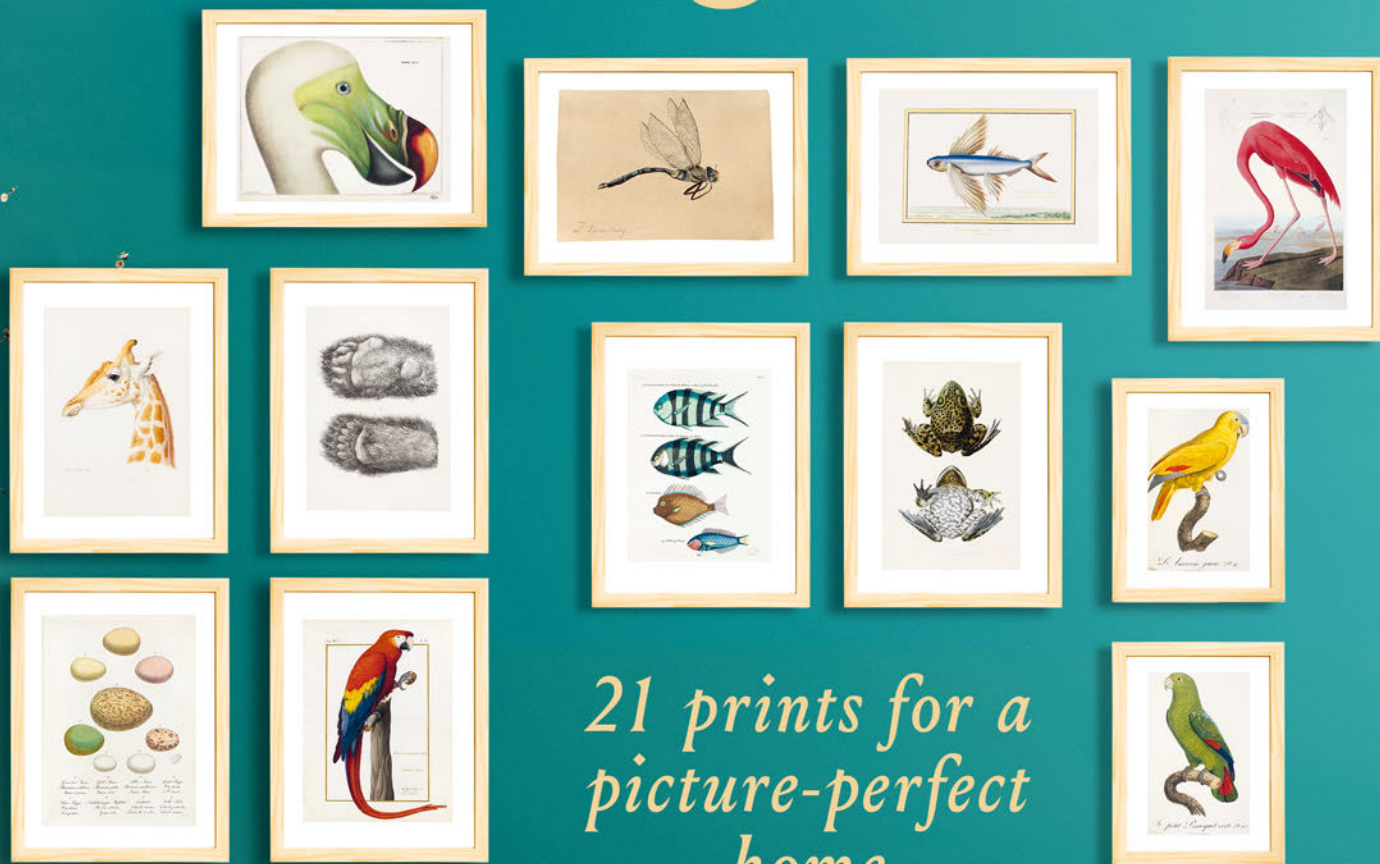


The secret to creating a successful display is to establish interactions between key elements formed by colors or contours. A horizontal line will be the perfect counterpoint to a vertical motif, for example.

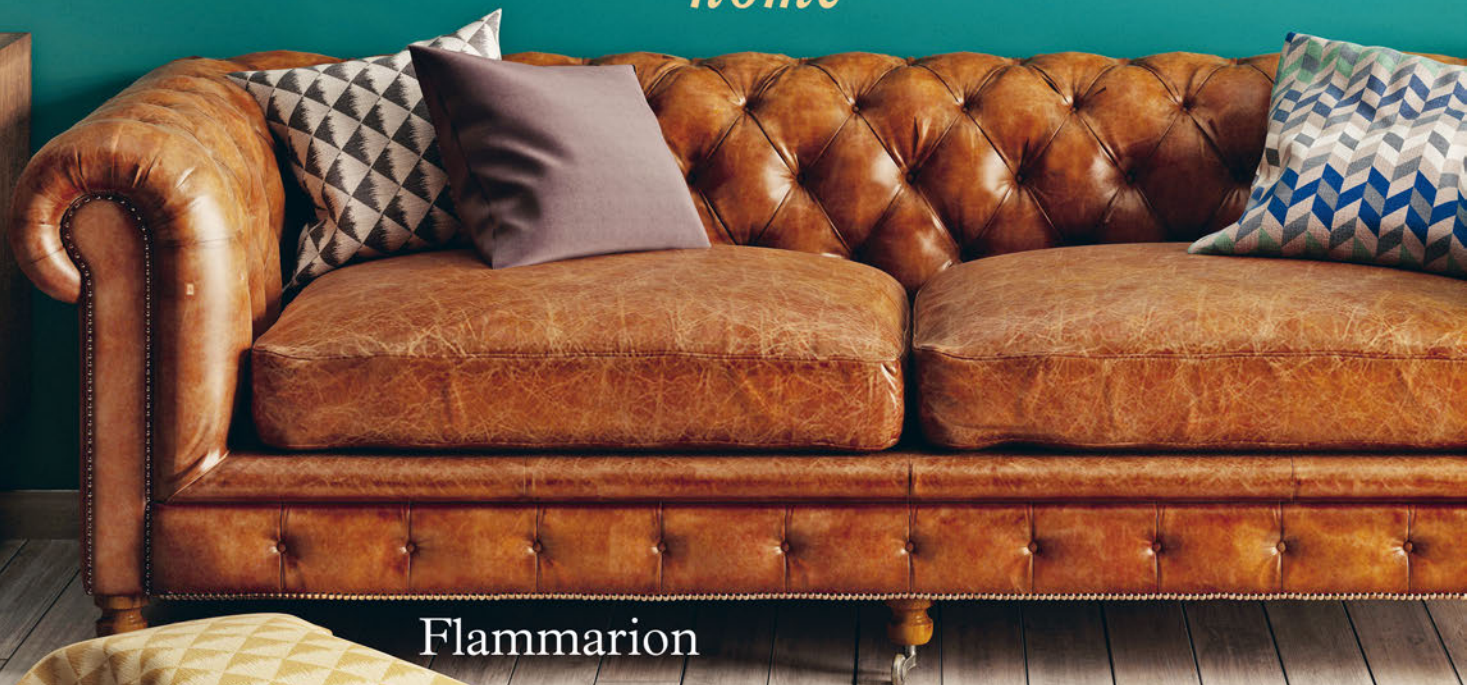
Changing the display regularly will instantly update your decor.
